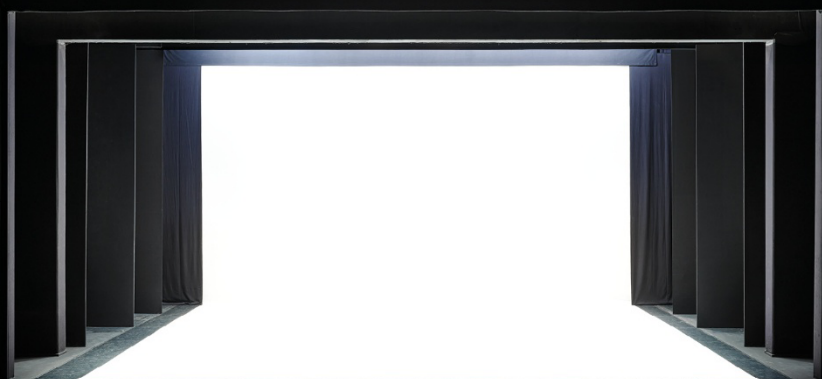

What is 'A Possibility'?

A Possibility is a contemporary **music performance** made by an artist called Germaine Kruip.

Assistive listening is available at this venue. Please speak to a member of the Front of House team to access this.



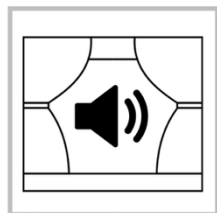
Assistance dogs are welcome throughout the building. The venue can recommend appropriate seating for assistance dogs when you book.

ABOUT THE PERFORMANCE

A Possibility is a contemporary **music performance**. It is **1 hour 40 minutes long** and has two acts:



Act 1 is a **performance** exploring **light** and **shadows**.



Act 2 is a **sound artwork** using **percussion** and **brass sculptures**

The performance includes:



Intense **flashing lights**



Blackouts (total darkness)



Loud sound effects



If you leave the theatre during this performance, you will **not be allowed** to go back in.



Phones, smart watches and other **light-emitting devices** are **not allowed** whilst the performance is happening.

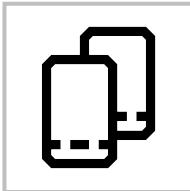


There is **no spoken content** in the performance.
