What is 'An Inheritance'?

An Inheritance is an **exhibition** made by school children from Manchester.

Manchester International Festival

The event is part of Manchester International Festival (MIF).

MIF is a festival that happens every 2 years in Manchester bringing the most exciting artists on the planet to Manchester to create new work.

This event is at **Manchester Art Gallery**, in Gallery 2.

Venue Entrance

The **main entrance** is on **Mosley Street**. There is a ramp leading to the main entrance from **Nicholas Street** with handrails.

There is a wheelchair lift and stairs at the entrance on **Princess Street**. This entrance has an automatic revolving door.

VENUE ACCESSIBILITY



There are **accessible toilets** on the **ground floor** and on **the first floor**. They do not require a radar key.



Guide and assistance animals, including **assistance dogs** in training, are welcome at the gallery.



There are **benches** to sit on in the gallery. And **portable stools** available near the lifts on the ground floor.



A **quiet area** for prayer or reflection is available. You can reserve this space before your visit or ask about it when you arrive.

An Inheritance is an **exhibition** made by **children and young people** from Manchester.

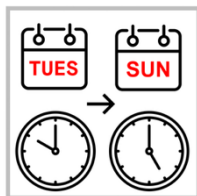


The young people have been thinking about **Manchester 100 years from now** and what they can leave behind for the children of the future.
