### **Venue Entrance**

The **main entrance** to the venue is on Ducie Street and is down **13 stairs**.



The **accessible entrance** is to the right of the main entrance, down a wide concrete slope.

# **VENUE ACCESSIBILITY**



There is an **accessible toilet**. You do not need a radar key to use the accessible toilet.



Inside the venue is **step-free**. The floor is uneven concrete with a gentle slope.



Assistance dogs are welcome in our building.

If you are bringing an assistance dog to a ticketed event, **please let us know in advance** via email or phone (see back page).



Because the venue is a **disused warehouse**, the **temperature** inside is **cool** and there are some areas with **low ceilings**.

# ABOUT THE EVENT



The event is a **performance** including **music, text and dance**.



Audience members are invited to **move around the space** during the performance whilst listening to the music and watching the dancing.



There will be **seats available**, including some portable stools.

The event is **1 hours and 50 minutes long**, with no interval. **Reentry is allowed**. There will be a bar in the space.

# ABOUT THE PERFORMANCE



This performance often **changes quickly** from slow, quiet and intimate to fast, loud and overwhelming.



There will be heavy use of haze.



There will be heavy and sustained **strobe lighting**. There is a sequence of repeated strobe effects which lasts approximately 5 **minutes**, which takes place **55 minutes** into the performance.



The sound levels get **very loud** at certain moments.



The sound includes music and live instruments that may be **overwhelming** and **difficult to listen to**.
