What is 'Football City, Art United'?

Football City, Art United is an exhibition, with 11 different art works including participatory, visual, video and audio art.

Manchester International Festival

The event is part of Manchester International Festival (MIF).

MIF is a festival that happens every 2 years in Manchester bringing the most exciting artists on the planet to Manchester to create new work.

This event is in the **North Warehouse at Aviva Studios.**

Aviva Studios Entrance

You can approach Aviva Studios from **Liverpool Road** or **Quay Street**. Once you're inside, you will enter 2 large double doors and head to the first floor by stairs or lift.

The building will be **busy and noisy** during the festival

If you need **help** you can ask a member of our team. **FOH wear orange t-shirts**, and **volunteers wear red t-shirts.**

VENUE ACCESSIBILITY



There are **accessible toilets** on the **ground floor** and the **first floor**.

You do not need a radar key to access the toilets. There are gendered and gender-neutral facilities.



There is a **Changing Places toilet** on the **ground floor**.



Assistance dogs are welcome in our building.

If you are bringing an assistance dog to a ticketed event, **please let us know in advance** via email or phone (see back page).



There is a **chill out space** at Aviva Studios. It is on the **ground floor**, in the Lab.



Portable sensory kits are available.

Tickets



You **need a ticket** for this event. You can book this online, by phone, email, or in person at our venue.

Entry



Entry is timed. Once you have entered, you can stay for as long as you like.



The entry is through a corridor **with low lighting and loud sounds** of a football stadium.

There is an **alternative entrance** if you do not want to go through the corridor. Please ask a staff member if you need this entrance.



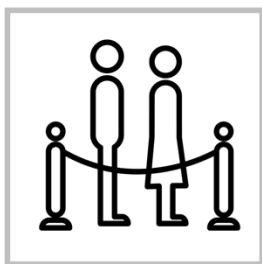
If you need to **take a break**, leave the space and **come back in**, that's fine. Just talk to one of our team.

ABOUT THE EXHIBITION

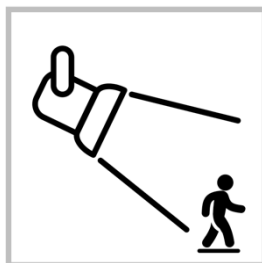


There will be **11 different artworks** in the space including **participatory, visual, video and audio art**.

You can choose which artworks to experience, and in what order.



The exhibition may be **busy** and there may be **queues** to interact with some of the artworks.



One of the artworks includes a **spotlight** that follows audience.



There is an artwork where you can **kick a football**. You may hear kicking noises inside the space.

EXHIBITION ACCESS



There is **step-free access** to all areas of the venue, with lift access to the North Warehouse. The exhibition is step-free and there is access for wheelchair users throughout.



Film content in the exhibition is **captioned**.



A **transcript** is available for all audio content.
